The **TCA sponsored Streetscape and Shade Structure** project provides a permanent, outdoor shaded area for the public on the CASP campus and within the Lubbock Cultural Arts District, as well as new landscaping, improved sidewalks, and outdoor sculpture pads. Permanent seating and other amenities will be added at a later date.

The **CH Foundry** provides an affordable, local option for casting and pouring aluminum and bronze sculptures. The Foundry is available for use by artists and participants in CASP classes and workshops.
